The PPRC also voted to re-affirm its prior endorsements of Ian Urriola, a graduate of Wesley Theological Seminary, and currently a Chaplain and Director of Spiritual Development and Outreach at Shenandoah University, and of Michael Mullin, a graduate of Colgate Rochester Crozier Divinity School, and currently Minister for Discipleship and Youth at Asbury First.

Joint Meeting with Governing Board, Transition Team, and Rev. Ted Anderson

District Superintendent Suzanne Block, Rev. Ted Anderson and Mary Connors Anderson joined the meeting. District Superintendent Block introduced Rev. Anderson as the proposed Interim Senior Minister appointed by Bishop Burgos to serve Asbury First from March 1, 2024 through June 2024. Rev. Anderson's compensation and Jim Quinn shared this information with the Committee, after which he signed the necessary compensation forms. Rev.
