GETTING YOUR VACCINE

Everyone age 12 and older is eligible to receive a free COVID-19 vaccine in New York state. Walk-ins are now accepted for all regional health department and state-run clinics and some pharmacies. Those being vaccinated at their pharmacy can make an appointment or check with their pharmacy to see if they accept walk-ins.

Check our Appointment Finder and the county-by-county list below to get started. *NOTE: Currently, only the Pfizer/BioNTech vaccine can be given to those 12 and older. The Moderna and Johnson & Johnson/Janssen vaccines are for use in those 18 and older.*
